#### **SOME DEFINITIONS**

#### What is **discrimination**?

- A treatment to others that is prejudiced
- An action towards others that is prejudiced

#### What is **racism**?

- Racism is discrimination against a person of a certain racial or ethnic group, purely because of their association to the group
- Overt racism is an obvious act of discrimination, done so with malicious intent
   Eg, Racism towards Adam Goodes
- **Systematic** racism is racism that occurs in the systems, laws and practises of society. This racism is more subtle and not often recognised for what it is Eg, White Australia Policy



#### MORE DEFINITIONS

What is **cultural understanding/acceptance**?


To have a thorough understanding and comprehension of culture and recognise its value

What is **tolerance**?

In informal wording, **tolerance** is to 'put up' with something denoted undesirable


What is **stereotyping**?


A fixed, or generalised belief about a particular group or class of people
