Thank you for interest in becoming a VicSRC Member. This page outlines some frequently asked questions and the legal information you need to know before signing up. We've tried to make it as simple as possible but if there is anything that's difficult to understand or you have any questions please contact us on membership@vicsrc.org.au. More information about what it means to be a Member is included in our Constitution.

We encourage you to sign up as a Member if you want to have a say in who makes up the Board of Trustees, which oversees the strategic direction of the organisation as determined by the Student Executive Advisory Committee.

Can I become a Member? (eligibility criteria)

You are eligible to be a VicSRC member if you are a primary or secondary school student living *or* attending school in Victoria. If you are not currently enrolled in a school, you are eligible to be a VicSRC Member if you are between the ages of 6 - 17 (inclusive) and live in Victoria.

Do I have to pay anything?

No, VicSRC membership is free.

However, in the unlikely event that VicSRC has to close down and has outstanding costs that need to be paid, each Member may be required to pay up to one dollar (\$1) to help cover these costs.

What can I do as a Member?

Elect the VicSRC Board of Trustees

Attend, speak at, and vote at the VicSRC Annual General Meeting (AGM). The AGM is the yearly meeting of all VicSRC Members and the Board of Trustees.

As a VicSRC Member, you are automatically a part of the VicSRC Student Community, which means you get updates and opportunities from VicSRC and can vote in the VicSRC Student Executive Advisory Committee election. More information is available here: <u>join.vicsrc.org.au/students</u>.

Membership Register

The VicSRC must maintain a Register of Members in accordance with the Corporations Act which contains Member's name, addresses and membership start/end dates for current and recent former Members.

What if I want to be involved with VicSRC but don't want to become a Member?

Renewing your Membership

Membership needs to be renewed each year you are still in school. You will be sent a renewal form via email. If you do not complete and return the renewal form, your membership is automatically cancelled after 3 months.

What do I do if my details change?

If you change your home address or email address, or any other details, you must let us know within 28 days by emailing membership@vicsrc.org.au.

What do I do if I don't want to be a Member anymore?

You can resign your membership at any time by sending us an email at membership@vicsrc.org.au saying that you no longer want to be a Member.

You can also send us a letter addressed to VicSRC, c/o Our Community House, 552 Victoria Street, North Melbourne 3051.

What happens to my membership if I graduate school, move interstate or do something else to become ineligible?

A person automatically ceases to be a Member if you no longer meet the eligibility criteria. Its helpful to let us know if you are no longer eligible to be a Member so we can remove you from our Membership Register.
