EDUCATION STATE OUTCOMES AND CURRICULUM COMPETENCIES

Teach the Teacher supports schools to implement both outcomes and all five elements of the Framework for Improving Student Outcomes (FISO) through the key actions from Amplify:

- Review existing processes to capture school and community views and understandings of student voice, agency and leadership.
- Identify trends and correlations between different data sets to identify persisting or emerging issues in student engagement and the use of student voice, agency and leadership.
- Involve students in discussion and enable them to contribute their unique perspectives on learning, teaching and schooling.
- Provide ongoing support for adult-student partnerships by establishing clear structures, roles and responsibilities for implementing mutually agreed goals.
- Invite existing student representatives to set up new structures with broader student participation in decision making.

Teachers who participate in Teach the Teacher at their school can receive formal acknowledgement of professional development activity that references the Australian Professional Standards for Teachers.

Teach the Teacher supports your school to:

- develop and improve student-teacher relationships
- harness student knowledge and perspectives to shape innovative teaching and learning
- build student agency to support student engagement, outcomes, health and wellbeing
- develop a school culture of respect and inclusivity
- create a positive and collaborative school community
